We have experienced the great awakening in the hearts and souls of the broken hearted and desperate. The ones who have no hope. Those who have been rejected, abandoned, forgotten because of life's circumstances. Whether it be generational, life choices are due to the unforeseen happenstances in life. When you take a look around you can see so many people that are being held in bondage in their own inner prison. This lead us to our next move of God our women's conference.

We have witnessed God drawing the homeless back to himself as he awakens their spirit within them. Some of them are very confused and didn't even understand what is happening to them. They find themselves sharing their darkest secrets and they cannot explain why. In order for people to get free the Lord has to reveal the hidden things the enemy uses-against us.

The Desoto Community Center is Owned and operated by Larry and Cindy Latham they started the Desoto Community Center 14 years ago. Cindy said that she was in the right place at the right time to overhear a conversation about them selling of the old Baptist church in De Soto she was a member of that church, she said that God kept nudging them to purchase the building.

She said in her mind it seemed impossible, but God was working behind the scenes and made a way for it to all work out.

It was their hearts desire to make a difference in the community; they wanted to serve the community in a greater way. Little did they know the homeless people in the area would start showing up and they would feed them. They feed about 26 homeless people a day and they let them shower in the facility.

They do all of this out of the kindness of their heart and ask for nothing in return showing them the love of Christ. They have witnessed many through their help get back on track in their life.

You never know what one act of kindness can do to a lost and hurting soul.

A friend of ours who has a ministry called Behind the Scenes. She mentors the youth and young adults equipping them through spiritual warfare and life's challenges. And also, is mentoring an inmate who had lost hope and is encouraging him that no matter where you are God can use you and He has a plan for your life.

Alena received a call from Pam a friend of ours that was a part of our tent revival. Telling her of a young woman around the age of twenty-two, God had called her to start having a backyard Bible study. Pam encouraged her to step out and trust the Lord. You never know how God is going to use you but through your obedience you can touch lives for the Kingdom.

After our tent revival in 2024 Carlen asked God what was next; she had a dream about us having a woman's conference

Years prior to that, the Lord gave Alena a dream and a vision about a brides' conference.

We started receiving confirmation for the women's conference and started in motion.

One of Carlen's customers told her about the Desoto Community Center, that they had a church connected to it that would be a great venue for the conference.

That is where God gave us the divine connection with Cindy and Larry Latham.

We have had the honor of being able to lead the homeless to the Lord and even just sit down with them to hear their stories. One-man in particular named Chris sit with us for three hours sharing about how his struggles stemmed back from childhood and carried into his adult years and how he turned to drugs to escape his past. With tears flowing down his face, he asked us do you think God would ever forgive me. This was an open door to share the power in forgiveness, not just that God forgives but that you also need to forgive yourself. Chris had told us he kept being drawn back to the church but because of his guilt,

shame and condemnation he didn't feel worthy to go through the doors. We told him God wants you to come just as you are and leave the rest up to Him. One particular time while we were there, we heard a piano playing and it was Chris revealing one of his hidden talents.

God has set up many divine appointments each of them with their own story to tell.

We have seen God stir the hearts of the homeless, they keep coming back wanting more, wanting to know more about God. Wanting God to heal the anguish they have in their soul.

It's a beautiful thing to tell each and every one of them that God can meet them where their at. That he loves them, he's not giving up on them, he's drawing them to himself, they were made for more than where they're at. You don't have to be homeless to be separated from God.

It is no coincidence that God has us there. Not only will we be holding our first conference there but He has also provided us with a room so we can do our podcast and interviews.

We have experienced God is on the move and awakening people's hearts to the revival. If people can't bring themselves to come to church God is moving people in the church to the streets to witness.

It's not about taking anything away from the church, because we are at the church. It's not about being a rebellion of going rogue it's about going to the places that nobody else will go to reach the lost. The word tells us to go out into the world and make disciples, so the gospel can spread like fire.

With our yes and the leading and guiding of the Holy Spirit you can accomplish great things.
